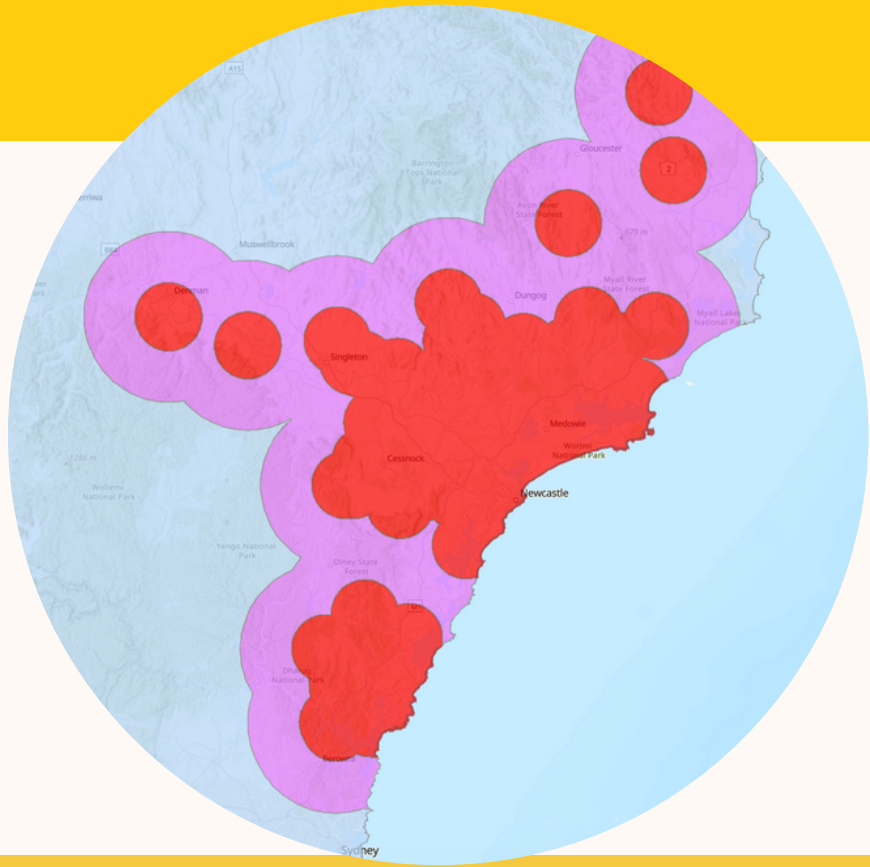

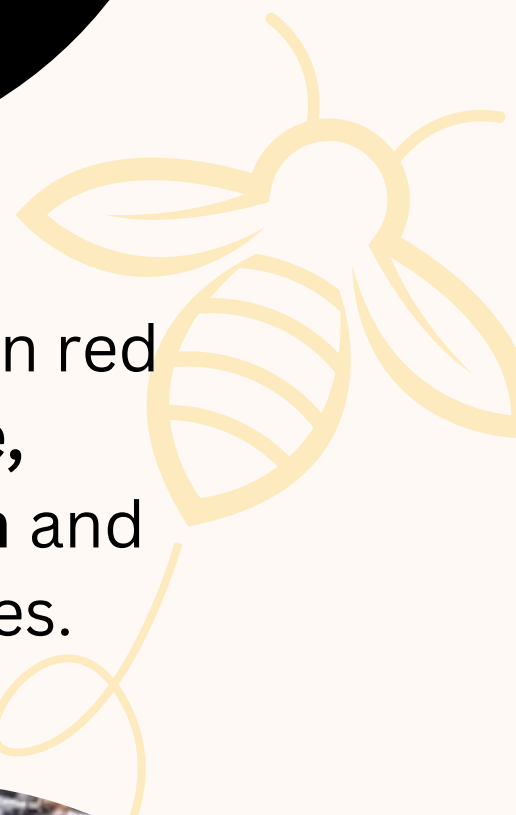
TOXIC INSECTICIDE

Fipronil is a highly toxic broad spectrum insecticide currently banned in 45 EU countries and restricted in US, Canada and UK to protect native insects and honeybees.



Fipronil bait stations

DPI have deployed 600 Fipronil baiting stations within red & purple zones across **Central Coast, West Newcastle, Bulahdelah, Wards River, Wherrol Flat and Krumbach** and are at varying stages of their feeding and spiking cycles.



Thousands of hives destroyed

Under the current Biosecurity (Varroa Mite) Emergency Order, the DPI wields unquestionable power to enforce any orders given by the NSW Government. It's estimated over 25,000 beehives have been destroyed by the DPI.



TAKE ACTION

Contact your local council and state representatives to prompt them to put pressure on the Federal Government to review the Emergency Use Order and transition to an appropriate management strategy.
